JA Dollars with Sense is an online program for students in Grade 7. This is an interactive tool that helps young learners develop personal money management skills and apply them to their daily lives. Students will find out how they can make informed consumer decisions and understand different money management practices.

Virtual Volunteer-Led Program

- ▲ JA volunteer(s) will run the activities and facilitate the program using an online video conferencing tool
- ▲ Online program is 90 minutes
- ▲ Teacher should set up access and remain on the line for the duration of the presentation
- ▲ JA will provide additional activities/resources for teachers who would like to continue the learning

Teacher-Led Program

- ▲ Teachers can run the program with their class and facilitate all the activities
- ▲ JA will provide access to the JA Campus with the online resources
- ▲ Teachers can run the program at their own pace
- ▲ Program usually takes 2-4 hours to complete



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Program Activities Include:

- ▲ Discover the value of different currencies
- ▲ Discuss when to use different forms of payment
- ▲ Gain the tools needed to prepare a project budget
- ▲ Identify financial needs, wants and goals at different life stages
- ▲ Gain a better understanding about credit and interest
