### More than Money: Making Money Decisions

Grades 3-4

Students will think like a business owner and make money decisions for an end of year school celebration.

**Students will:**

- Develop a money plan (budget)
- Learn and reflect on effective strategies to create a business pitch

### Our Business World: Build a Business for Your Community

Grades 5-6

Students will come up with strategies to build a new business in their community.

**Students will:**

- Define how businesses help communities
- Brainstorm potential businesses that would benefit their community
- Develop financial business scenarios
- Present their business idea to the class

### Dollars with Sense: Financial Flexibility

Grade 7

Students will plan for their next purchase while dealing with unforeseen challenges.

**Students will:**

- Understand how to plan to meet a goal
- Create a financial plan for a future purchase
- Define how to become a smart consumer
- Research costs for a new purchase and determine the necessary payment plan

### Economics for Success: Teen Room Upgrade

Grade 8

Students will make a purchasing decision, examining hidden fees, additional costs and overall advantages and disadvantages.

**Students will:**

- Research where they can purchase items
- Understand the value and rewards of credit
- Calculate hidden costs, taxes and currency exchange for a purchase



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
